# **Timed Event Rules and Information for 2010**

## **Speed events are run with closed gate. No exceptions**

### **Rules**

**Proper attire required for all classes. No Tank Tops. Boots, and jeans or long pants are required. Helmets are recommended.**

Stallions must be handled by persons 19 yrs and over. Stallions must be stalled or in their trailer at all times except when being shown.

No excessive use of whips, bats or spurs.

Ages are as of January 1, 2010 (riders).

**Ponies are 56" & under. Horses are over 56".**

No re-rides because of faulty tack.

No Refunds for any reason.

Not responsible in case of accidents, injury or theft.

**Class entry closes two classes before.**

TROPHY & RIBBON classes (**all classes with riders under 14**) will receive a trophy for first place and a ribbon for 2<sup>nd</sup> thru 6<sup>th</sup>. The trophy can be exchanged for \$5.00. There is no other pay back in these classes.

JACKPOT classes will have an additional \$5.00 fee. Payback will be 40-30-20-10.

**Jackpot does not count toward high point awards.**

**STALLS available for rent (\$15/Day-sawdust required). You must furnish your own sawdust bedding & clean out stall before leaving.** Stall cleaning available for \$20/stall. See registration table.

#### High Point

**Separate Points for T&C Year End High Point will be earned at all four shows.**

You must be a member of the club to be eligible for high point awards.

All Timed Events are included for Speed Events High Point.

Scoring split for awards is 6 5 4 3 2 1 unless there are not 6 in the class. The points are given according to the number in the class. i.e. 3 in class - first gets 3 points, second gets 2 points, and third gets 1 point.
